OLD TESTAMENT READING

The reading is taken from Genesis 32:22-31 Let us prepare ourselves for the word of God. **Our hearts and our minds are open.**

New Testament Reading

The reading is taken from Luke 18:1-8 Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. **Glory to you, O Lord.**
